As per G.O.No.18465/H. Dt.18.07.2017 (Prospectus for admission into D.Pharm. course in Odisha) the minimum eligible criteria for admission into the course is pass in 10 +2 Science examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and/or Mathematics from C.H.S.E., Odisha or any examination equivalent to it, approved by Pharmacy Council of India (PCI). Though +2 Council has considered Diploma in Engineering equivalent to +2 Sc., the subject nomenclature is different from Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics & Biology. PCI has not considered the Diploma in Engineering as a minimum qualification for admission into D.Pharm. course. So the students with Diploma in Engineering qualification are not eligible to study D.Pharm. However on the request of such students, they were kept under consideration, subject to their eligibility to be decided by PCI. They were informed through the merit list that their candidature is not final & is subject to approval of PCI. As PCI has not yet approved Diploma in Engineering as a minimum qualification, the candidature of such students is now cancelled and they are not eligible for admission into D.Pharm. course.
